There are innumerable worms in our world - and many of them are parasitic - that is, they live inside other animals and plants. The parasitic worms that infect people are a major public health problem in the developing world, where they are the cause of many tropical diseases. Dr. Pearce will talk about the fascinatingly weird biology of these dangerous organisms.



Dr. Pearce received his Ph.D. in the Division of Parasitology at the National Institute of Medical Research in London. He established his independent research program at Cornell University in 1991, relocating his laboratory to the University of Pennsylvania in 2001. Dr. Pearce joined the Trudeau Institute as a member of the faculty in 2009.
